Welcome to the Wills Cemetery. The Directors hope our visitors find everything satisfactory during their visit this Memorial Day weekend.

We encourage supporters of the Cemetery to purchase memorial bricks for \$30.00 each in memory of their loved ones to be added to the walkway. Forms for purchasing the bricks are available in the box attached to the sign inside the Memorial Garden. The Peculiar Garden Club is maintaining the Memorial Garden as a new project and everyone appreciates and thanks them for their efforts. This is to become a beautiful meditation area for visitors to the Cemetery.

In 2008, there were 20 burials and in 2009, as of May 1, there have been 4 burials. Because of continuing need, additional land was purchased and is being prepared for use. As the result of a recent donation, fencing has been installed around this land. To enhance the entire cemetery, trees have been planted in the new area.

The cost of a grave site continues to be \$300.00.

Maintenance and improvements of the cemetery are expensive and therefore tax-deductible contributions would be greatly appreciated, as well as suggestions and comments. Please use the attached envelope to send your donation.

Please remember that the decorative items placed on the ground for Memorial Day can remain for 2 weeks. After that time the items not removed will be discarded so mowing and maintenance can resume.
